## PROPOSAL FOR AN EXCEL<sup>®</sup> SPREADSHEET TO ACT AS A SCORESHEET OPTION FOR ISAC CONTESTS IN ADDITION TO PAPER SCORESHEETS

Imagine for a moment that you are master scorekeeper, John Whitaker, and you have just come to your office from the icy Grinnell, IA landscape. A ton of scoresheets (some of which have dubious legibility) lay on your desk waiting to be entered onto the master scoresheet for the year. You and your faithful assistant Marna have been harassed for the umpteenth time by the evil Newsletter Editor, Frank Lukes, to send the ISAC scores for *The Atlatl*. As you stare wistfully over the lovely Grinnell Campus, you wish that there was a way for all these scores to be placed onto a spreadsheet so that you could copy and paste the results onto your master spreadsheet and send the result to that d--n Frank.

In answer to John's wishes I have been developing an ISAC scoresheet on Microsoft Excel<sup>®</sup>. The design of the spreadsheet is to allow results to be directly incorporated onto the master spreadsheet that the master scorekeeper maintains to tally results for a given year. The spreadsheet IS NOT PROPOSED to replace the paper scoresheets currently in use. Rather the spreadsheet version is a supplement and can be used in a variety of ways to tabulate and transmit scores. Advantages for use of the spreadsheet include:

- Better legibility for the data submitted.
- The spreadsheet automatically tabulates the scores accurately.
- Various “saber metrics” (use of data for statistical analysis) can be enhanced.
- Results can be easily transmitted via e-mail to the master scorekeeper.
- Data can be easily transferred from scoresheet submissions to the master scoresheet for the year by “copy and paste” mechanisms.
- It is possible to make copies of individual scoresheets for participants that have an exceptional or memorable score.

Disadvantages include:

- Availability of equipment (lap top, Ipad, smartphone, etc) for data entry.
- Security – A number of the cells on the spreadsheet are protected. The cells or spreadsheet can be password protected if necessary.
- Transferring data from paper sheets to the spreadsheet can be time consuming if one desires to transmit the data to the master scorekeeper electronically after gathering all the paper scoresheets. This could have a silver lining since the spreadsheet automatically calculates scoring totals and would act as an additional check for final scores.

Opening the spreadsheet brings you to the “Summary Sheet” tab (see Figure 1) . The following features are to be noted:

- The header shows “DATE” (MM/DD format — year fills in automatically), “LOCATION”, and “YEAR”. These are the only cells on this tab into which the user can place data. The remaining cells on the sheet are automatically filled in from the individual matches as the data is entered. – The data from the “DATE” and “LOCATION” cells is automatically entered onto each of the match scoresheets.
- All of the data for each match is automatically transferred to the proper cells on the “SUMMARY SHEET” from the individual “MATCH” scoresheets (see the multicolored tabs across the bottom of the “SUMMARY SHEET”). A “MATCH” would be 3 to 5 individuals per ISAC throw.
- The spreadsheet allows for a maximum of twenty matches with five participants. If there are more than 100 participants on a given day, a second spreadsheet would need to be started.
- I suggest that the copy of the spreadsheet be saved under a name that describes the event and date of the matches (e.g. “Cahokia091818). This will distinguish the individual spreadsheets by date of throw for a given meet.

By choosing one of the multicolored “MATCH” tabs on the bottom of the spreadsheet, an ISAC scoresheet is opened, (see Figure 2)

I have placed a yellow highlight on each of the spaces that the scorekeeper should fill with appropriate data (the date and location have been filled from the entry on the SUMMARY tab):

1. For each participant in the match enter the first name, last name, residence city, residence state/ country into the appropriate spaces.
2. The highlighted WEATHER box is a drop down box with a choice of “1”, “2”, and “3”. This is a subjective choice by the scorekeeper between Excellent, Good, and Poor conditions. John Whitaker has been assigning the conditions value based on the descriptions placed on the written scoresheets. The scorekeeper should use their best judgement.
3. The SEX spaces for each participant are dropdown boxes allowing the scorekeeper to choose either MALE or FEMALE.
4. The EQUIPMENT boxes for each participant is also a dropdown box that the scorekeeper will choose either OPEN or PRIMITIVE equipment.
5. The individual confirming the scoresheet is responsible for assuring that all data has been entered on the scoresheet.

The scoresheet is now ready for ISAC contest scores to be entered. A score is entered for each throw just as would be done for a handwritten scoresheet. “0” is entered for a miss. Either “x” or an “X” for a hit in the “X” area of the target. The other scores are entered like on the written scoresheet. The following fields are automatically calculated on the scoresheet:

1. Total score at 15 meters for each participant.
2. Total score at 20 meters for each participant.
3. Total match score for each participant

All of the data from each MATCH scoresheet transfers automatically to the SUMMARY SHEET. As you examine the SUMMARY SHEET portion of the spreadsheet you will note the following breakdown next to the entries for each match (Figure 3).

The spreadsheet tallies the hits in each of the target areas at 15 METERS, 20 METERS, with a TOTAL HIT SUMMARY for each match.

Figure 4 shows a scoresheet filled out for a mythical match in Sherwood Forest, England. Figure 5 shows the data that has dropped onto the SUMMARY SHEET. Figure 6. shows the HIT SUMMARY for the match. Please note that the mythical thrower, Robin Hood has thrown a perfect 100 ten “X”, This entry shows that the spreadsheet can accommodate perfection.

To summarize the process for utilizing the sheet:

1. Load the spreadsheet onto your device and **save the file under a new name** that matches the event title.
2. On the "Summary Sheet" portion of the spreadsheet enter the "DATE" and "LOCATION" for the day's matches. From these entries the date and location are automatically filled in on all the match sheets.
3. The scorekeeper for each match enters or assures entry of FIRST AND LAST NAME, HOMETOWN, STATE/COUNTRY, WEATHER. AGE (for Youth Category), and "EQUIPMENT". All this information is automatically copied to the "SUMMARY SHEET".
4. The scorekeeper then enters the score for each throw for each participant. The score for each participant is automatically calculated for "15 METERS", "20 METERS", and "TOTAL SCORE". This information is automatically copied to the "SUMMARY SHEET".
5. The scorekeeper enters his/her name on the scoresheet. A second person confirms the data entry by assuring that all the data is filled in on the sheet and a score is entered for each throw and enters his/her name on the scoresheet.

This spreadsheet is in Excel<sup>R</sup> format. I have loaded the spreadsheet using Apple's Numbers<sup>R</sup> program. I have not tested the program on other Excel<sup>R</sup> compatible formats. I will be sending the spreadsheet to Janeen Grohsmeyer, the Website Manager, **to make it available to the membership to play with and allow comment and improvements to enhance future use.** This sheet is only a proposal, and is not yet ready to be used to tabulate and transmit scores. I have titled the spreadsheet "ISAC SCORESHEET — MASTER". I also plan to act as a *shadow scorekeeper* at several events to compare "electronic scorekeeping" with the paper scoresheet system.

I look forward to input from our members.

## The 2018 Champions

506 people (65 youth, 121 women and 320 men) made 1,793 entries in the ISAC in 2018. [Participants represented nine countries as follows: North America – United States (34 states and Puerto Rico), Canada; Europe – France, Spain, Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, Italy; Australia] In the following list of top ten people in each division, each person is followed by their highlights of the year. The number in parentheses is their top-five aggregate (youth 40, women 50, men 70) for those who qualify. The “batting average” is the number of 90’s thrown divided by the games thrown for a total year or career.

- 1 - 96X Marlin Bassett - NY (90.48). *Five-time World Champion. New Youth World Record. Ninth time* in the Top 10. Set new record for most career games (489) for any youth in ISAC history (only youth over 80 games)
- 2 - 88X Carter Ashley - TN (threw 3 games) Fourth time in the Top 10 of seven “Board Years” and eighth highest score ever thrown by a 15-year-old.
- 3 - 87 Leilani England - MO (63.02) *Personal record* and second time in the Top 10.
- 4 - 82 Silas Springer - OH (74.22) *Personal record* and third time in the Top 10 of three “Board Years”.
- 5 - 78 George Reed - ID (threw 4 games) *Personal record* and in the Top 10.
- 6 - 73 Caleb Gates IV - CO (threw 4 games) Fourth time in the Top 10 of five “Board Years”.
- 7 - 68 Quay Fogelman - PA (threw 3 games) *Personal record* and in the Top 10.
- 8 - 59 Dylan McCaw - CO (threw once) Fourth time in the Top 10 of nine “Board Years”.
- 9 - 59 Hannah Ariel - TN (threw once) *Personal record* and in the Top 10.
- 10 - 58 Ruben Cuevas Pozo - Spain (threw once) *Personal record* and in the Top 10.
