cruitment of new members and maintain an adequate supply of membership forms to be made available to the general public at convenient times and locations; may maintain and sell items to the membership at a discount to the members and profit to the Association. The Executive Secretary shall be a co-signer on the WAA Checking account; perform all duties incident to the office, and such other duties as may be assigned by the President or Board of Directors.

As part of the Executive Secretary duties, Debbie Andrews maintains the event calendar. Events can be submitted directly on the WAA website, sent to Debbie's email, or sent via postal mail (see contact information posted in this article). The form below can be clipped, filled out and mailed to Debbie for addition to the event calendar.

- Only events posted on the WAA website calendar qualify to have the ISAC scores recorded by the ISAC Scorekeeper
- Events should be posted at least one month prior to the scheduled start date. (If you want the event posted in the newsletter the posting must appear on the website prior to the deadline for publication). The ISAC Committee must approve any deviation from this deadline.

Executive Treasurer (Anita Lukes —interim appointment) — Per the WAA bylaws

• The Executive Treasurer shall maintain the membership list as they collect the annual dues and keep a record of their collection by name, address, and date of payment. The membership list shall be available to only the Board Members and those determined by the Executive Board; shall promptly notify the Executive Secretary of the names and addresses of those who have paid their dues; shall maintain an up-to-date financial journal of all cash, checks, receipts, and accounts due of the Association; shall keep an insured bank account and a complete record of deposits and withdrawals; shall compile and issue a financial report of the Association as required by the Board of Directors and the law; shall issue an annual financial report of the Association at an annual meeting, and shall perform all duties incident to the office and such other duties as may be assigned by the President or the Board of Directors.

An important part of the Executive Treasurer's job is the maintaining the membership roster. The roster tracks active and inactive members on a spreadsheet. The spreadsheet **is separate from the internet to protect member privacy.** Having an up to date and accurate member roster is vital for the function of the WAA. Anita Lukes has been able to resolve a large number of membership issues by contacting affected parties by email, cell phone, or mail. Having complete and accurate information as part of the membership roster is vital for the following functions:

- Distribution of the WAA Newsletter (**The Atlatl**). As editor of the newsletter, I often have emailed copies of **The Atlatl** not delivered because the email address is invalid. The same happens for postal mailings when the address has changed.
- WAA Elections Lori Majorsky, The Election Administrator for WAA, must have accurate email addresses to submit to our election vendor (Election Buddy) for members to cast votes in WAA elections. For those members not using email an accurate postal address is required to mail out the WAA ballot.
- Committees like the Nominating Committee and other officers (e.g. President, Executive Secretary, etc.) require occasional use of the member roster to complete WAA business. Again, having accurate and complete contact information within the roster is vital for the WAA.

Official ISAC Scorekeeper (John Whittaker):

The Scorekeeper maintains a master spreadsheet where all ISAC scores are recorded from **sanctioned WAA events** (as mentioned previously in this article, sanctioned events are those published on time on the event calendar on the website or newsletter via the Executive Secretary). Within this spreadsheet the Scorekeeper maintains a list of high scores within the Men's, Women's, and Youth categories that meet or exceed high score criteria. The high score lists are published in **The Atlatl** and are used to determine the year end champions for each category.

Sending or transmitting scoresheets to John Whittaker was described in the Summer 2023 (Volume 36, Number 3 — Pages 1-3) edition of **The Atlatl.**

Missing or disputed ISAC scores should bed addressed to John Whittaker. However, John's records of ISAC scores are only as good as the quality of the scoresheets he receives. **Legible, accurate, and complete ISAC scoresheets** are necessary for John to perform his work. I will repeat what I have published before, **if you or your fellow atlatists cannot read it, John cannot read it.**

Webmaster (Michael Caldwell):

Michael Caldwell is new to the position of WAA Webmaster. Michael is learning about the workings of the WAA website and has already implemented improvements to make the site easier to navigate.

Log in issues, website questions, and suggestions for changes to the site should be addressed to the Webmaster.

Newsletter Editor (Frank Lukes):

Finally we come to me, the intrepid Newsletter Editor. Part of my motive for writing this article is to clarify the function of key positions for WAA so that inquiries can be directed to the correct party. I will continue to direct questions or concerns regarding WAA events, membership issues, website log in problems, etc. to the correct individual. However, the answer may come more quickly with direct contact with responsible WAA officers.

The newsletter is published four times per year roughly in January, April, July, and October of each year. Contribution of news and pictures from WAA events is always welcome in **The Atlatl.** Any articles that you think would interest our members would be helpful for The Editor.

DUES INCREASE TO \$20

The Board of Directors at the 2024 Annual Meeting in September voted to increase dues to \$20 for individual and for family members.

In the early days of the organization during the late 90's, dues were \$10 Around 2000, dues were increased to \$15 for individuals and \$20 for families. Fifteen years later, the Board voted to change to the dues to \$15 for both individuals and for families. Ten years later, dues are still \$15 even though costs have risen.

I reviewed our current yearly income and expenses. Below are my findings:

Yearly income is \$1695 from dues

73 individual members

40 families (with 61 dependents, i.e., partners, children)

113 paying entities

TOTAL $113 \times $15 = 1695

Yearly expenses

Newsletter printing and mailing costs	\$1050
Website fees and maintenance	1120
Top Ten Awards (plaques and mailing)	720
Postage/Supplies	140
TOTAL	\$3030

DEFICIT OF \$1335. This does not include smaller additional expenses and income from a small amount of merchandise sold from the web store.

Fortunately, the added revenue from Supporting and Contributing members as well as an additional \$640 in donations amounted to \$1345.

So, for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, the organization is breaking even.

However, there is no certainty that we will continue to have the same or higher levels of Supporting and Contributing members, nor the level of other contributions. Therefore, the Board chose to raise the dues modestly this year:

Individuals and Families \$20 These changes are
Supporting membership \$40 reflected in the member
(Defined as 2 x the Individual dues) application on Page 2
Contributing membership \$80

(Defined as 4 x the Individual dues)

If you have paid your dues for 2025 at the \$15 level, you do not owe any additional money. If you have paid ahead for multiple years, you do not owe any additional money.

Award Plates Available at No Cost from WAA

Did you know that Grand Champion plates are available from the WAA? These are at no cost to the event organizers, and available to mount on your own event award. Whichever way you organize your grand championship, there are a few rules that must be followed.

The base for the award must be purchased or made by the event organizer. Only the metal plates are available at no cost.

The rules for your Grand Championship may include the results of one or more local contests, **but ISAC scores** <u>may not</u> be included.

An example is taken from Ohio's Pawpaw Festival and That Dam ISAC contests. The plaques are made by Steve Barnett, and the plate is mounted on the plaque. The championship is determined by the Ohio Local Contest, with the highest score in each class (novice men, novice women, master men, master women, youth and senior) in a head-to-head competition for the championship, throwing 3 darts from an assigned distance. Normally, younger and/or less-experienced throwers throw from distances closer to the target while more experienced throwers are placed farther from the target.

The plate is approximately 5" X 3" in size.
